The Hound of Ulster: Of all the early literatures of Europe, two from opposite corners of the continent, have obvious comparisons, the Greek hero Achilles and the Irish champion Cuchulain. The scope of the paper concerns the long-standing debate about the relation between two medieval sources, i. e. the 'Historia Gothorum' by Cassiodorus and the 'Getica' by Jordanes, and the role of the former in the politics of Theoderic the Great at the beginning of the sixth century A. D.
